## **12U A1 - FACTS SHEET**

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| TUITION             | Team Tuition: \$3,150 (minimum roster size: 11 skaters and 1 goalie; maximum roster size: 15 skaters and 2 goalies)  A \$500 non-refundable deposit is due at signing with the balance paid in installments by November 1, 2024. Tuition includes practices, games & tournaments, coach stipend & travel expenses, administrative expenses and overhead. Refunds are defined in the player agreement and only issued for catastrophic circumstances as determined by the Ogden Jr Mustangs. The program may, at its discretion, prorate the tuition to determine the refundable amount, if any. Player Releases, from the OJM program, are not eligible for refunds. The cost of soft goods is not refundable.  |
| ICE                 | Approximately 80 hours of practice ice and approximately 50+ games per season.  Practices will be primarily at the Weber County Ice Sheet located at 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden, Utah.  |
| TRAVEL              | Travel A teams will travel three or more times, out of state, for hockey games. Plan to travel at least six times, out of state. Travel may include league events, tournaments & weekend series events. Player and family travel costs are not included in the tuition. Players are expected to travel to all team tournaments.   |
| SOFT GOODS          | Soft goods (game jerseys, game shells, game socks, team helmet, team gloves and player gear) are not included in tuition. Players are required to buy team gear including game jerseys, pant covers, gloves, socks, track suit, shorts, and t-shirt. Other soft goods may be requested by the coach. Samples for sizing may be available during tryouts. Orders must be made by parents, individually. Costs can range from \$200 to \$400+ for players new to the Jr Mustangs. Returning players are not required to purchase new gear but must have game gear in good condition. Soft goods will be invoiced separately from Tuition invoices.  |
| COMPETITION         | Teams may compete in the Rocky Mountain Hockey Federation as their primary league. Teams may participate in the local travel league (UTHL) at the discretion of the head coach.   |
| EXPECTATIONS        | Players are expected at all events. There is no discount for missing a tournament, game series or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents and guardians are expected to act with utmost character and to abide by the USA Hockey Codes of Conduct. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their player(s). Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule when communicating with coaches. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, the players, opponents, volunteers, and the game officials. The team's communications tools are for team business only and not to be used for other purposes. |
| ADDITIONAL<br>COSTS | Any costs associated with additional tournaments, showcases, games, etc. that are not in the team's budget (for example, qualifying for an International Silver Stick Final or choosing to extend the season with an additional tournament or series of games) will be split among parents who voluntarily choose to attend the additional events.  |
