14U TRAVEL A - INFORMATION SHEET: 2010 & 2011 BIRTH YEARS

Team Tuition: \$3,100-Skaters; \$2,900-Goalies

\$500 due at signing with the balance paid in monthly installments by November 1,2024.

Tuition includes practices, games & tournaments, coach stipend & travel expenses, overhead and administrative expenses. Refunds are defined in the player agreement and only issued for season ending injuries and catastrophic circumstances as determined by the Ogden Jr Mustangs Executive Leadership. The program may, at its discretion, prorate the tuition to determine the refundable about. Cost of soft goods are not refundable.

Approx. 75 hours practice ice (approx. 2-3 per week), approximately 45 games per season. Practices will be at the Weber Ice Sheet, 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden Utah.

Travel A teams must travel at least 3 times out of state. Plan to travel to approximately six (6) possibly more, out of state tournaments (approx. 1 per month). Tournaments include league events, in or out of state tournaments & weekend series events. Player and family travel costs are not included in the tuition. Out of state tournament expenses incurred by a player and parent can range from \$800 upwards of \$1500 per tournament. These costs are paid by the parent/guardian. Players are expected to travel to all team tournaments.

Soft goods (uniforms & team apparel and gear) are not included in tuition. Players are required to buy team jerseys (home and away), pant covers, gloves, socks (home and away), team jacket and team pant, shorts, and t-shirt. The team bag is optional. Navy blue helmets may be required at the discretion of the coach. Orders must be made by players, individually, online from the Team Store. Costs can range from \$0 for a returning player to \$400+ for players new to the Jr Mustangs. Returning players are not required to purchase new gear but must have game gear in good condition. Game jerseys, shells and socks will be sized at tryouts session.

Teams may compete in the Rocky Mountain Hockey Federation and/or in the local travel league (UTHL) at the discretion of the head coach. The head coach will choose tournaments and game opponents that are competitive and in line with the Utah Amateur Hockey Association requirements for Travel A division teams.

Players are expected at all events. There is no discount for missing a tournament, game series or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents and guardians are expected to act with utmost character. Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule when communicating with coaches. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, the players, opponents, volunteers, and the game officials.
