TUITION	Team Tuition: \$1300 (Minimum roster size: 18 skaters and 2 goalies) A \$250 non-refundable deposit is due at signing with the balance paid in installments by November 1, 2024. Late Registrant payment terms will differ and may include payment in full. Tuition includes practices, games, administrative expenses and overhead Tournaments will cost extra. Refunds are defined in the player agreement and only issued for catastrophic circumstances as determined by the Ogden Jr Mustangs. The program may, at its discretion, prorate the tuition to determine the refundable amount, if any. Player Releases, from the OJM program, are not eligible for refunds. The cost of soft goods is not refundable.
ICE	Approx. 90+hours practice ice (approx. 2-3 per week), approximately 25 games per season. Practices will be at the Weber Ice Sheet, 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden, Utah.
TRA VEL	Travel B teams may travel up to three out of state tournaments. Travel includes league events, tournaments & weekend series events. Player and family travel is not included in tuition. Players are expected to travel to all team tournaments.
SOF T GO ODS	Soft goods (uniforms & team gear) are not included in tuition. Players are required to buy team jerseys, pant covers, socks & track suit. Other soft goods may be requested by the coach. Samples for sizing may be available during tryouts. Orders must be placed by a parent. Costs can range from \$0 for returning players to \$300+ for player new to the Jr Mustangs. Soft goods will be invoiced separately from the Tuition fees. Players may use their jr Mustangs game jerseys and socks from the 2023-24 season.
CO MPE TITI ON	Teams may compete in the Rocky Mountain Hockey Federation as their primary league and may participate in the local travel league (UTHL) at the discretion of the Head Coach. The head coach will establish the tournament and game schedule in compliance with USA Hockey and Utah Amateur Hockey Association policies.
EXP ECT ATI ONS	Players are expected at all events. There is no discount for missing a tournament, game series or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents and guardians are expected to act with utmost character and to abide by the USA Hockey Codes of Conduct. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their player(s) and their guests. Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule when communicating with coaches. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, the players, opponents, volunteers, and the game officials. The team's communications tools are for team business only and not to be used for other purposes.
ADD ITIO NAL COS TS	Any costs associated with additional tournaments, showcases, games, etc. that are not in the team's budget (for example, choosing to extend the season with an additional tournament or series of games) will be split among parents who voluntarily choose to attend the additional events.
