14U TRAVEL A TEAM - FACT SHEET

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	Anticipated Team Size: 15 skaters and 2 goalies (Minimum roster size: 13 skaters and 1 goalies) Team Tuition: \$2,700 Skater; Team Tuition: \$2,600 Goalie
TUITION	A \$500 non-refundable deposit is due at signing with the balance paid in installments by November 1, 2025. Tuition includes practices, games fees, tournament entry, skills coaches, practice jersey, practice socks and helmet stickers, expenses related to program and team administration. No Refunds. The program may, at its discretion, may prorate the tuition for season ending injury or catastrophic event. Player Releases, from the OJM program, are not eligible for refunds. The cost of soft goods is not refundable.
ICE	Approx. 65 hours practice ice (approx. 2-3 per week). Approximately 45-50 games during the season. Practices will be at the Weber Ice Sheet, 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden, Utah and possibly the greater Salt Lake Valley rinks. From time to time, the rink may cancel ice with little notice. Make-up ice will be scheduled where possible but not guaranteed.
TRAVEL	The team will travel to multiple (approx. 4-7) out of state tournaments. Approximately 1-2 per month. Travel events include friendlies, in-state and out-of-state tournaments, RMHF League games and events. Most travel will be drivable. Player and family travel is not included in tuition. Players are expected to travel to all team tournaments.
SOFT	Soft goods (uniforms & team gear) are not included in the player tuition. Players are required to buy JOG brand team game jerseys (home & away), game socks, game pant covers, team jacket, team joggers, team warmup shorts & tee. Optional are team hoodie, caps, beanie, navy gloves and navy helmet. Additional soft goods may be requested by the coach. Samples for sizing will be available during tryouts. Orders must be placed by a parent/guardian. Costs can range from \$0 for returning players to \$400+ for a player new to the Ogden Jr Mustangs. Players may use their JOG brand Jr Mustangs game jerseys, socks, warmups and joggers from the 2024-25 season.
COMPETITION	Teams will compete in USA Hockey Sanctioned Tournaments and events including the Utah Amateur Hockey League and the Rocky Mountain Hockey Federation League. The head coach will establish the tournament and game schedule in compliance with USA Hockey and Utah Amateur Hockey Association policies and team revenue. The season will conclude at the UAHA hosted Travel State Tournament (mid-February).
EXPECTATIONS	Players are expected at all events. No discounts for missing a tournament, game series or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule when communicating dissatisfaction with coaches. The exception is Safesport violations or when the incident involves imminent danger for the parties involved. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, the players, opponents, volunteers and the game officials and abide by the USA Hockey Code of conduct for parents and spectators. Unacceptable conduct by a parent, guardian, parent's guest/spectator at a Jr Mustangs event may result in being asked not to return to the venue while Jr Mustangs activities are underway. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their player(s) and their guests.
	Ice time for players, during game play, may not always be equitable, particularly in competitive circumstances. Playing time is at the discretion of the head coach. The team's communications tool (TeamSnap) is for team business only and not to be used for other purposes. A player missing OJM events in favor of other hockey teams is grounds for release from OJM. OJM does not issue player
	tuition refunds. All grievances are to be submitted using the OJM online dispute resolution form found on the website - https://jrmustangshockey.com/home-copy/governance/
ADDITIONAL COSTS	Post season team play must be pre-approved by the OJM executive leadership. Costs associated with tournaments, showcases, games, international qualifiers, etc. that are not in the team's budget will be split among parents who voluntarily choose to attend the additional events. All such activities and events must be authorized by OJM Leadership in advance of the event and costs must be determined and payment arrangements made in advance of registering for additional team activities.
