8U TRAVEL - FACT SHEET

TUITION	Anticipated Team Size: 14 skaters (goaltending will be rotated among the rostered skaters). Team Tuition: Skater \$1,625, Goalies \$1625 (Maximum roster size: 15 skaters and 2 goalies) A \$500 non-refundable deposit is due at signing with the balance paid in installments by November 1, 2025. Tuition includes practices, games & tournaments, skills coaches, administrative expenses and overhead. No Refunds on player tuition after an agreement to accept a spot is signed by the parent or guardian. In the event of a catastrophic circumstance, the Ogden Jr Mustangs, at their discretion may choose to prorate tuition. Player Releases, from the OJM program, are not eligible for refunds. The cost of soft goods is not refundable.
ICE	Approx. 60 hours practice ice (approx. 2-3 per week), approximately 20-25 games per season. Practices will be at the Weber Ice Sheet, 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden, Utah.
TRAVEL	Travel B teams may travel up to three out of state tournaments. Travel includes league events, tournaments, friendlies & weekend series events. Player and family travel is not included in tuition. Players are expected to travel to all team tournaments.
SOFT GOODS	Soft goods (game uniforms & off ice apparel) are not included in tuition. OJM Travel team players are required to buy team game jerseys, game socks (Champro Brand), off-ice jogger and hoodie (JOG Brand as available for ordering). Other soft goods may be requested by the coach. Samples for sizing may be available during tryouts. Orders must be placed by a parent. Costs can range from \$0 for returning players to \$300+ for player new to the Jr Mustangs. Players may use their jr Mustangs game jerseys and socks from the 2024-25 season (Champro Brand reversible jerseys and socks).
COMPETITION	Teams will compete in the local travel league UTHL. The head coach will establish the tournament and game schedule in compliance with USA Hockey and Utah Amateur Hockey Association policies. Plan for at least three instate tournaments and two possibly three out of state tournaments. Approximately 2 additional local jamboree style events (1 home and 1 away) are dependent on local teams being available, willing and eligible to participate in games/jamboree events. In-state jamborees are dependent on the number of Utah-based 8U travel teams fielded and whose programs allow and budget for additional competition. Goal is to complete the season no later than the end of February 2026.
EXPECTATIONS	Players are expected at all events. No discounts for missing a tournament, game series or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule when communicating dissatisfaction with coaches. The exception is Safesport violations or when the incident involves imminent danger. In those cases, local law enforcement should be contacted immediately. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, the players, opponents, volunteers and the game officials. Unacceptable conduct by a parent, guardian, spectator at a Jr Mustangs event may result in being asked not to return to the venue while Jr Mustangs games, practices, events are underway. Registration for 8U Travel teams means that the player will be at all practices and competitions throughout the season.
ADDITIONAL COSTS	Any costs associated with additional tournaments, showcases, games, etc., that are not in the team's budget (example: choosing to extend the season with an additional tournament or series of games), will be agreed upon by the organization and parents. Additionally, the expenses associated with participation in additional events will be split among parents who voluntarily choose to attend the additional events.

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
