



OJM 4U DEVO– FACT SHEET

<p>TUITION</p>	<p>Anticipated Team Size: Registered Players will be split evenly amongst multiple groups to facilitate Player and Coach Development as well as prepare and play in inner-squad and USA Hockey sanctioned program to program games in the state of Utah. Registered Players capped at the discretion of OJM. Any combination of Skaters and Goalies as decided on by Head Coach. Goaltending encouraged to be rotated among all rostered skaters.</p> <p>Team Tuition: Skaters and Goalies \$200.00</p> <p>Full payment of \$200 is due at signing with the balance paid through Teamsnap, OJM’s merchant service provider. Optional payment methods include a check payable to Jr Mustangs Hockey for the total balance paid up front to accept team offer. Tuition includes practices, game fees, end of season tournament entry (if offered in this division by the UAHL), non-parent skills coaches, dryland training as scheduled and expenses related to program/team administration. No Refunds. Upon offer acceptance full payment is due and paid upon selected payment terms in Teamsnap. Player Releases from the OJM program are case by case, require full payment and are not eligible for refunds. The cost of soft goods is separate from Tuition and is non-refundable.</p>
<p>ICE & DELIVERABLES</p>	<p>Approx. 6 hours practice ice (approx. 1 ice touch per week for 6 weeks as scheduled by OJM Saturdays, or another day scheduled by the program, November-December), including: Perfect Skating Skills Sessions coached by approved and rostered OJM Coaches as assigned by OJM. Sunday team events scheduled at the discretion of the program. Practices will be at the Weber Ice Sheet, 4390 South Harrison Blvd., Ogden Utah and other rinks as assigned by OJM. From time to time, the rink may cancel ice with little notice. Make-up will be scheduled where possible but not guaranteed as arranged between the program, Team Manager and Head Coach. Player Tuition also includes one group photo as scheduled by OJM photographer. Players and Coaches must attend their OJM-assigned picture day.</p>
<p>TRAVEL</p>	<p>DEVO team events include friendlies, in-state League games and events as offered by UAHL in this division. Away games not guaranteed and may take place anywhere within the state of Utah. Participation by all DEVO Players, Coaches, Managers and Volunteers encouraged. Player and family travel is not included in tuition. Players are expected to commit to travel to all team events with accompanying parent/guardian or Safesport approved travel supervisor.</p>
<p>SOFT GOODS</p>	<p>Soft goods (uniforms & team gear) are not included in the Player Tuition. DEVO teams will use the same Champro jerseys as the 2025-2026 season. Players are required to buy assigned team game jerseys if new size or number are needed (home & away), game socks (home & away) and have navy blue or black helmet, gloves and breezers (hockey pants). No helmet colors besides navy blue or black allowed. Optional items include OJM jogger and hoodie. All OJM Players, Coaches, Managers, Volunteers and Staff must represent OJM name, image and likeness at OJM sanctioned ice time and team activities.</p> <p>Optional items are available year-round as posted to jrmustangshockey.com Pure Hockey store. Samples for sizing for DEVO teams will be available shortly after registration as scheduled assigned by OJM. Orders must be placed by a parent/guardian. Costs can range from \$200 for returning players to \$400+ for a player new to the Ogden Jr Mustangs. Parents place order and pay vendor directly (separate from Player Tuition).</p>

<p>EXPECTATIONS</p>	<p>Players and their USA Hockey defined Parent/Guardian/Relative must be residents of Utah. No Billets allowed. Players are expected at all team events. No discounts for missing a tournament, game series, practice or team event. Players are expected to respect the game, teammates, coaches, officials, opposing players, and facilities. Parents must abide by the 24-hour rule AND utilize OJM's Conflict Resolution Policy posted to jrmustangshockey.com. The exception is Safesport violations or when the incident involves imminent danger in which case USA Hockey Safesport and/or safesport@jrmustangshockey.com should receive an intake form to take immediate action. Parents are expected to respect one another, let the coaches coach, make timely payments toward their player's account, be supportive of the program, all players, opponents, volunteers and game officials and abide by the USA Hockey Code of Conduct for parents and spectators. Unacceptable conduct by a parent, guardian, spectator at a Jr Mustangs event may result in being asked not to return to the venue while Jr Mustangs activities are underway. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their player(s) and their guests. The team's communications tools (TeamSnap) are for <u>team business only</u> and not to be used for other purposes. Missing OJM events in favor of other hockey teams is grounds for release from OJM. OJM does not issue player tuition refunds. All grievances are to be submitted using the OJM online grievance form referenced above found on jrmustangshockey.com OJM reserves the right to change, cancel, update goods and services listed, reassign ice time, team events, locations, actual cost, coaching staff and roster size at any time without notice. All OJM tournaments, practices, games, sponsored and sanctioned team events are for rostered Players, Coaches and Volunteers only and USA Hockey rules apply. Parents and other family members may be included at their expense depending on the event type.</p>
<p>ADDITIONAL COSTS</p>	<p>Costs associated with additional tournaments, showcases, games, qualifiers, etc. that are not in the team's budget will be split among parents who voluntarily choose to attend the additional events. All such activities and events must be authorized by OJM Leadership in advance of the event.</p> <p>Tournament Rosters fall into the category of additional expenses and viability will be explored by OJM Leadership after the season commences. Players should not expect a Tournament Roster opportunity, but may try out for one if it is offered. Competitive ranking will apply to Tournament Roster positions through a formal Tryout where additional expenses and deliverables are outlined and contracted separately.</p>
